Potential themes for discussion: Our life with a historic building made green – first hand experiences of its users Renovation of historic buildings vs. building new ones Adoption of green solutions in historic buildings – pros and cons Presentation and talk with Katarzyna Przyjemska-Grzesik, manager of the Krakow in Greenery team, focusing on how the big idea of the Symbiosis Centre – mindful looking at the world and adopting a new perspective offer us a deeper understanding – has been put in practice. Potential themes for discussion: Why do we go with children to the forest and let them experience it with all the senses – what ecological education is all about? How anchoring in natural environment and local history helps shape and strengthen ecological awareness?
